

Ordering Numbers

ascend - to go upward

In the instance of ordering numbers: ascending order means from the smallest number to the largest number (least to greatest).

e.g. 13 46 78 89

descend - to move downward or to a lower position

To order numbers in descending order, begin with the largest number then move downward to the smallest number.

e.g. 92 65 51 29 6
