|      | Determiner                        | Pronoun                 |
|------|-----------------------------------|-------------------------|
| I    | It's <b>my</b> jumper.            | It's <b>mine</b> .      |
| you  | It's <b>your</b> cap.             | It's <b>yours</b> .     |
| he   | It's <b>his</b> jacket.           | It's <b>his</b> .       |
| she  | It's <b>her</b> swimming costume. | It's <b>hers</b> .      |
| it   | It's <b>its</b> shoe.             | –                       |
| we   | They're <b>our</b> clothes.       | They're <b>ours</b> .   |
| you  | They're <b>your</b> socks.        | They're <b>yours</b> .  |
| they | They're <b>their</b> trousers.    | They're <b>theirs</b> . |
