

Would Prefer, Would Rather

1. Would Prefer To

Would prefer va siempre seguido de infinitivo con to, igual que *would like to*.

would prefer to + verb

I would prefer to go out
She'd prefer to do it now
We'd prefer **not** to go out

*Preferiría salir por ahí
Preferiría hacerlo ahora
Preferiríamos no salir*

Recuerda que la negativa del infinitivo es *not to*.

Para decir prefiero hacer esto que hacer eso usando *would prefer*, tenemos que hacerlo usando *rather than*.

Would Rather

Would rather también significa preferiría, pero va siempre seguido de verbo en infinitivo sin to.

Lo más normal es usarlo en su forma contraída ‘d rather’.

‘d rather + verb

I'd rather stay in	<i>Prefiero quedarme en casa</i>
She'd rather do it now	<i>Preferiría hacerlo ahora</i>
We'd rather eat Chinese	<i>Preferiríamos comer chino</i>
