from: different from

for: for a long time, work for, for+period of time (for a few years), for the first time, prepare for smth (but prepare **to V1**)

in: in one's second year (of university), in+month, in+season, in+year (in 1992), arrive in+city/country

at: at the end of, at university

of: experience of, instead of

No preposition: influence smb/ smth, date smb, tell sb, to answer (**verb**) the questions, discuss smth, go home, face smth, call sb etc.
