- We use **singular nouns** when we talk about one person or thing.
- We use **plural nouns** when we talk about two or more people or things.
- We usually add **-s** or **-es** to make plural nouns.

most nouns	+ -s	ball	balls
-ch, -sh, -s, -x, -o	+ -es	bench dish bus fox tomato	benches dishes buses foxes tomatoes
consonant + -y	y + -ies	baby cherry	babies cherries
-f, -fe	f + -ves	leaf knife	leaves knives
