To form the opposite of some adjectives, we can put a prefix in front of them. The prefix *un-* is the commonest one meaning *not*, for example *unattractive*, *uninteresting*, *unintelligent*, *unpopular*. The prefix *im-* also means *not*. It is less common than *un-* and it can only go in front of words that begin with *m* or *p*, for example *impolite*, *impossible*, *impractical*.
