

Determine the HCF of 12 and 16

12 – 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 12

16 – 1, 2, 4, 8, 16

The HCF of 12 and 16 is 4

Determine the HCF of 28 and 42



The HCF of 28 and 42 is 7
