The Galápagos tortoise is the largest living species of tortoise, reaching weights of over 400 kg and lengths of over 1.8 meters. With life spans in the wild of over 100 years, it is one of the longest-lived vertebrates. A captive individual lived at least 170 years. The tortoise is native to seven of the Galápagos Islands, a volcanic archipelago in Ecuador. The tortoises have a large bony shell (carapace) of a dull brown color. The plates of the carapace are fused with the ribs in a rigid protective structure that is integral to the skeleton. Galapagos Tortoise diet consists on grasses, leaves and fruits. The tortoises are ectothermic (cold-blooded) and Tortoises sometimes rest in mud wallows or rain-formed pools, which may be both a thermos regulatory response during cool nights, and a protection from parasites such as mosquitoes and ticks.



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
