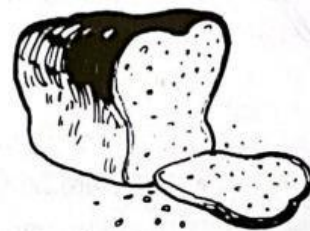

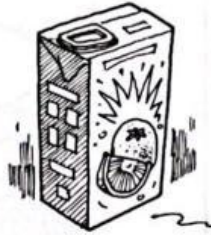

- In British English we use the word *can* for drinks: a *can of beer / cola / lemonade*. We use the word *tin* for food: a *tin of tomatoes / beans / apricots*. In American English the word *can* is used for food **and** drinks.
- We don't just use the word *bar* with chocolate. We also use it with soap.
- In formal situations, we talk about a *bouquet* of flowers, not a bunch.
