A. GRAMMAR: Quantifiers

Được sử dụng với **danh từ đếm được**.

A few = Some, thường mang nghĩa số lượng của một vật **đã đủ** hoặc **nhiều hơn mong đợi**.

a few / few

Few thường mang nghĩa số lượng của một vật **không đủ** hoặc **ít hơn mong đợi**.

Ex:

I have **a few** friends, so I'm not lonely.
She has **few** friends, so she's quite lonely.

Được sử dụng với **danh từ không đếm được**.

A little = Some, thường mang nghĩa số lượng của một vật **đã đủ** hoặc **nhiều hơn mong đợi**.

a little / little

Little thường mang nghĩa số lượng của một vật **không đủ** hoặc **ít hơn mong đợi**.

Ex:

We've got **a little** time before our train.
Shall we get a coffee?
We've got very **little** time before our train. Hurry up!

Đều được dùng với cả **danh từ đếm được và không đếm được**.

Some

Thường dùng trong **câu khẳng định**.

Ex: I can buy **some** books.

Trong **câu hỏi** mang tính lời mời - đề nghị.

Ex:

Would you like **some** milk for your black coffee?
Could you please buy me **some** oranges?

some / any

Thường dùng trong **câu phủ định và câu hỏi**.

Ex:

I don't have **any** pens.
Do you have **any** money?

Any

Dùng trong **câu khẳng định** mang nghĩa "bất cứ", **không giới hạn** lựa chọn.

Ex: She goes out with **any** boys whom she likes.

Dùng trong **câu khẳng định** mang tính phủ định.

Ex: We did it without **any** luck.
