

Multiplicación de fracciones

Numerador por numerador
Denominador por denominador

$$\frac{1}{3} \times \frac{3}{5} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{1 \times 3 \times 2}{3 \times 5 \times 3} = \frac{6}{45}$$

Reducir: $\frac{6}{45} \div 3 = \frac{2}{15}$ ← Fracción equivalente
