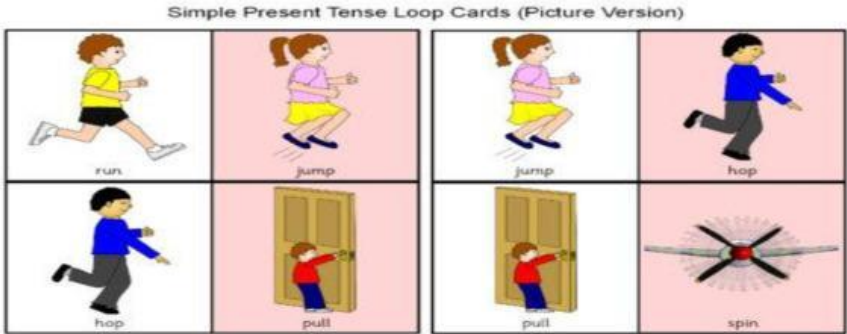

The **simple present tense** is used to describe habits, unchanging situations, general truths, and fixed arrangements.

Forms

- +** S + V(s/es) + O.
- S + don't/doesn't + V (base form) + O.
- ?** Do/does + S + V(base form) + O ?



Affirmative (+)	Negative (-)	Interrogative (?)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">I run fast.You run fast.He runs fast.She runs fast.It runs fast.They run fast.We run fast.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">I don't run fast.You don't run fast.He doesn't run fast.She doesn't run fast.It doesn't run fast.They don't run fast.We don't run fast.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Do I run fast?Do you run fast?Does he run fast?Does she run fast?Does it run fast?Do they run fast?Do we run fast?
