II. Match the following Bulakenyo crafts with their descriptions.



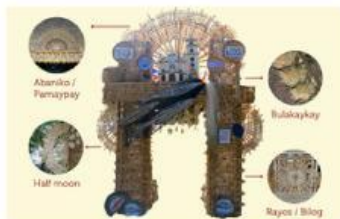
a. This is called "Singkaban". It uses straight and curve lines to show creativity of their bamboo decorations.
