

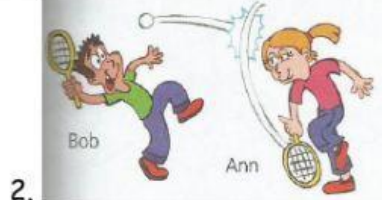
Q & A with (is, isn't, are, aren't)

(Look at the picture carefully. Then, click the correct answer. The first one had been done for you.)



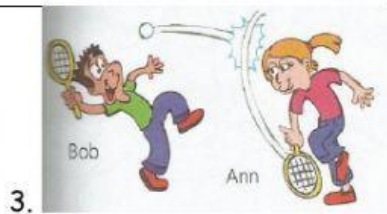
Q: (Is / Isn't / Are / Aren't) Kelly **cleaning** her house?
