We use **adjectives** to describe nouns. Adjectives tell us more about nouns.

The girl is **happy**.



These are **cute** kittens.
The kittens are **cute**.

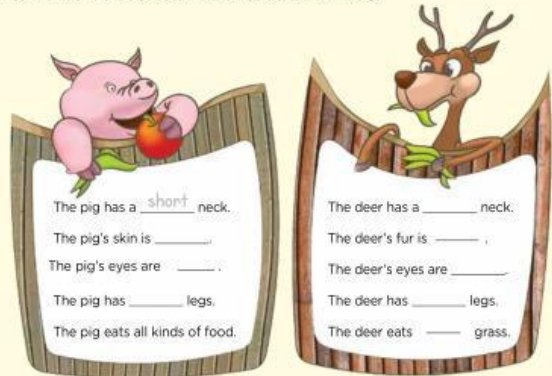
