	Comparative (So sánh hơn)	Superlative (So sánh nhất)
Tính từ ngắn	adj + -er + (than) Ex: Bill is taller than Jane. (Bill cao hơn Jane.)	the adj + -est + (N) Ex: Bill is the tallest person in the class. (Bill là người cao nhất trong lớp.)
Tính từ dài	more + adj + (than) Ex: A lion is more dangerous than a deer. (Sư tử nguy hiểm hơn nai.)	the most + adj + (N) Ex: The lion is the most dangerous animal. (Sư tử là loài nguy hiểm nhất.)

*Lưu ý:

- Tính từ 2 âm tiết tận cùng bằng **-er, -le, -ow, -et, -y**: được coi là tính từ ngắn, cụ thể:

+ clever (thông minh) => cleverer => cleverest

+ narrow (nhỏ hẹp) => narrower => narrowest

+ happy (hạnh phúc) => happier => happiest

- Tính từ có đuôi **-y**: chuyển **-y** thành **-i** rồi thêm **-er** hoặc **-est**:

+ easy – easier – easiest, pretty – prettier – prettiest

- Với tính từ ngắn, nếu trước phụ âm cuối là một nguyên âm thì gấp đôi phụ âm cuối, rồi mới thêm đuôi **-er** hoặc **-est**:

+ big – bigger – biggest, sad – sadder – saddest
