

WILL, BE GOING TO, PRESENT CONTINUOUS, PRESENT SIMPLE

	Cách dùng
Will	Thể hiện ý định của mình <i>ngay lúc nói</i> . → Độ chắc chắn: 0% – 50% Thường có các từ <i>hope (hy vọng), promise (hứa), think (nghĩ), ...</i>
Be going to	Thể hiện <i>sự sắp xếp và dự định cá nhân</i> đã có trước đó (không cần có chi tiết cụ thể), sự tiên đoán có căn cứ. → Độ chắc chắn: 50% – 80%
Present continuous	Thể hiện dự định hoặc kế hoạch cá nhân đã định trước, nhưng còn thể hiện thêm được sự chắc chắn (thường hay đi kèm với <u>chi tiết cụ thể</u>). → Độ chắc chắn: 80% – 90% .
Present simple	Nói về thời gian biểu, chương trình, lịch trình... (đối với các phương tiện vận chuyển công cộng, lịch chiếu phim, lịch kiểm tra.) → Độ chắc chắn: 100% .

EXERCISES

1. I hope Ben *is recovering / will recover* from his illness sooner or later.
2. I've already decided. I *won't lend / am not going to lend* my brother any money for the new car.
3. Madam, I can see your luggage is quite heavy. I *will take / am going to take* it if you don't mind.
4. *Are you doing / Will you do* anything tonight? We could go to the cinema or have a drink in a pub.
5. The weather forecast says it *is warming / will warm* up at the end of this week. At last!
6. I'm sorry, Peter. I can't go out with you tonight. Jim and I *will meet / are meeting* at the cafe.
7. Do you need an architect, because you *are opening / are going to open* a new

shop?

8. Hurry up, children. We *are leaving / are going to leave* by the 10.15 train from the Charing Cross station.

9. Please, put the vase back on the table or you *will break / are breaking* it.

10. I've bought the old house in Yorkshire, because I *am reconstructing / am going to reconstruct* it for my daughter.

11. Dad can't take you to school. He *is going to have / is having* an appointment at the dentist's at 8.30.

12. Where are you going, John? - To the back garden. I *am trimming / am going to trim* the hedges a little bit.

13. Tomorrow the sun *rises / is rising* at 6.44 according to the weather forecast. But we *leave / are leaving* for work one hour before that. It's terrible.

14. We *do not do / are not doing* anything tonight, we just want to watch a football m. It *starts / is starting* at 7 p. m. at Maracana Stadium.

15. Can you tell me what time *you meet / you are meeting* John on Sunday?
The Museum of Modern Arts *closes / is closing* at 5 p. m.

16. This year the school *ends / is ending* on Friday 28 June.
And we *set off / are setting off* on our family trip to the Isle of Man next day.

17. After the reconstruction the supermarket *opens / is opening* on Monday again.
And we *go / are going* shopping on Monday afternoon.

18. We *fly / are flying* to Barcelona on Saturday morning.
Don't forget that our flight *departs / is departing* at 6.25, but we have to be there two hours before that.

19. I *go / am going to* the bus station to meet Sarah tomorrow morning.
She *arrives / is arriving* at half past nine.

20. Do you want to join us? We *see / are seeing* Jane off tomorrow.
The ferry *leaves / is leaving* early in the morning.

21. I *take / am taking* part in the English language competition next week.
It *takes / is taking* place in the Lingua Language School.

22. We wanted to go to the cinema tomorrow, but they *do not show / are not showing* any good films.
We *have / are having* a small party instead. Would you like to come?
