Things We Subtract

¹ We use subtraction every day. When we buy things, we subtract to find out how much money we have left. Look at this example. Rosa had ten dollars. She bought a book for four dollars. She takes away four from ten and finds out she has six dollars left.

² We can subtract time too. For example, Kabir's class starts in forty-five minutes. He can walk to class in thirty minutes. He subtracts thirty from forty-five and finds out he has fifteen minutes left. Hurry up, Kabir!

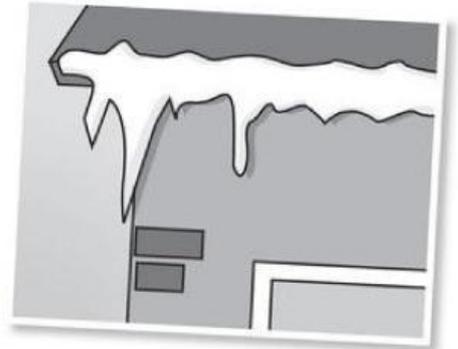
