

## Will

Subject + will/won't + infinitive

Express future actions decided at the moment of speaking (Immediate decisions)  
I will have the chicken sandwich.

Express a prediction based on personal opinions or experiences (Predictions without evidence)  
I think tomorrow will rain.

Express a future fact  
The sun will rise tomorrow.

## Going to

Subject + am/is/are (not) + going to + infinitive

Express future plans decided before the moment of speaking (prior plans)  
I am going to visit my children next weekend.

Express a prediction based on present evidence (Predictions with evidence)  
He is running so fast, he is going to fall.

Express something that is about to happen.  
The car is out of brakes, it is going to crash.
