

Simple Present Verbs

	DO	WANT	LIKE	HAVE
I	do	want	like	have
HE	does	wants	likes	has
SHE	does	wants	likes	has
IT	does	wants	likes	has
THEY	do	want	like	have
WE	do	want	like	have
YOU	do	want	like	have

Affirmative sentences: Subject + verb (s) + complement.

I want an apple. He likes spaghetti.

She wants a peach. They have french fries.

Negative sentences: Subject + do/does not + verb + complement.

I don't want an apple. We don't like eggs.

She doesn't have cheese. He doesn't want butter.





