Costa Rica: Top Destination for Responsible Tourism

Tourism helps us experience other cultures and admire the beauty of other places. 1 Aeroplanes and cruise ships cause high levels of pollution, while big resorts create huge amounts of rubbish. If we want to solve the problem of climate change, we need to become more responsible tourists. That means we should choose our destinations carefully.

Costa Rica is a destination which is famous for promoting responsible tourism. It is situated in Central America, with the Caribbean Sea on one side and the Pacific Ocean on the other. It is known for its diverse scenery which includes rainforests, jungles and beautiful beaches. 2 These natural features, as well as its tropical climate, attract millions of tourists to the country every year.

Until the 1990s, Costa Rica used to face the same problems as many other tropical tourist destinations. Rainforests were being cut down for their wood while rivers and beaches were being polluted by hotels and factories. 3 If they didn't protect these things, there wouldn't be anything for tourists to see in the future.

Since then, the Costa Rican government has worked hard to protect the environment and reduce the impact of tourism. More trees are planted than are cut down, which helps in the fight against climate change. 4 As well as that, national parks and nature reserves cover nearly 25 percent of the country, protecting the wildlife for generations to come.

The government has also taught locals and tourists how to look after the environment. For example, businesses receive awards for being the most environmentally friendly. 5 This type of accommodation gets its electricity from the wind or sun, which helps reduce air pollution. There are also recycling projects and beach clean-ups which aim to cut down land and water pollution and reduce waste.

Costa Ricans know that protecting the environment is essential for their country's future. If they don't look after Costa Rica's natural treasures, these might be lost forever. At the same time, tourism is important because it creates a lot of jobs and income. 6 As a result, Costa Rica has found ways to protect the environment and the opportunities of the local people. This is a valuable lesson for any country which depends on tourism.
