

## PRESENT SIMPLE vs PRESENT PERFECT vs PAST SIMPLE

### Remember:

If the action happened at an INDEFINITE or UNFINISHED time, or continues from the past till the present, we use **Present Perfect** (I have seen). It often describes personal changes.

If the action happened at a finished time not connected with the present, or we are interested in the details around the action (when, where, how), we use **Past Simple** (I saw).

If it is a present state or a habit, but we do NOT mention when it started, we use **Present Simple** (I see).
