

Food and cooking ideas have spread globally since the Stone Age, but knowledge about historical eating habits is limited compared to knowledge about other aspects of culture like housing and clothing. Before the 17th century, cookbooks were scarce, and even when they existed, they didn't always reflect common eating habits. Changes in food consumption were driven more by the movement of people, such as armies and merchants, than by written recipes. Most people relied on locally produced food due to limited transportation, and regional food was common with some people struggling to have enough to eat. Only the wealthy could afford diverse and exotic foods.
