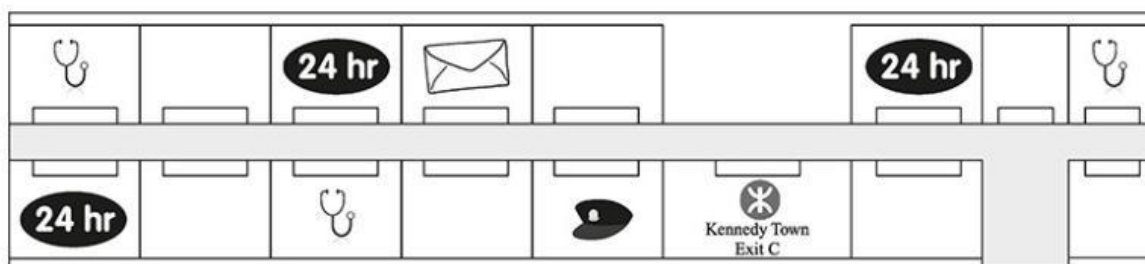
Take the MTR to Kennedy Town. Take Exit C. Turn left and walk straight ahead. Our learning centre is on your left between a clinic and a convenience store.
