- a) Copy this list of verbs on a piece of paper. They all have something in common, and they all have some things which are different from others:

be — break — choose — drive — eat — fall — forget - forgive - freeze - give - hide - ride - rise - see - speak — shake - steal— take - wake - write

- b) Use your piece of paper to classify them in 5 groups with the same type of irregularity, and one group with the rest.
- c) Now write the three forms of each verb IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER inside each group, and fill in the gaps in the example sentences with the correct form of one of the irregular verbs.

Count the number of verbs in each group and use the examples to help you find out the chart where you have to write them.
