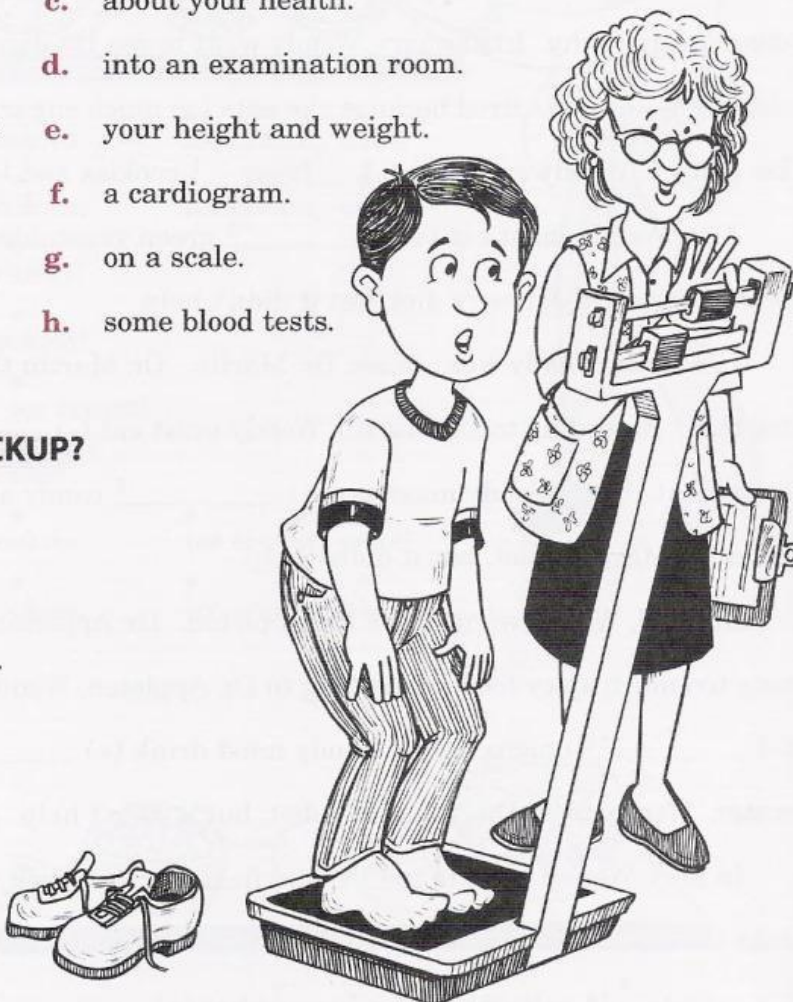

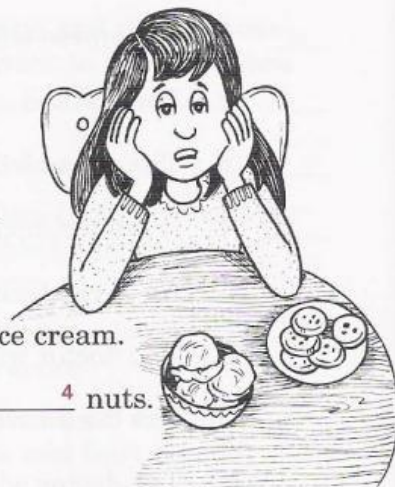


## C WENDY IS WORRIED ABOUT HER HEALTH

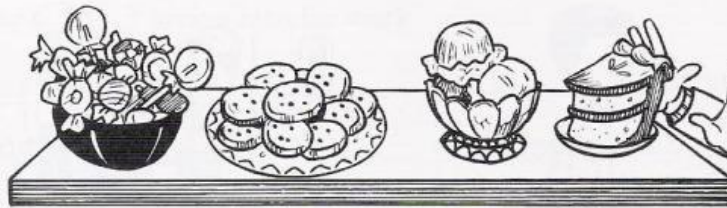

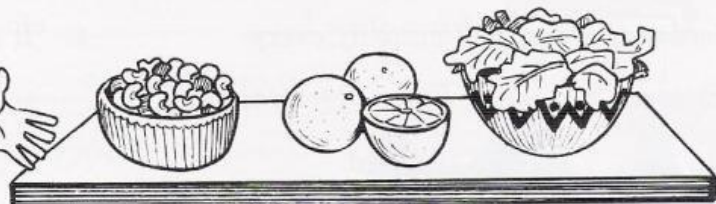

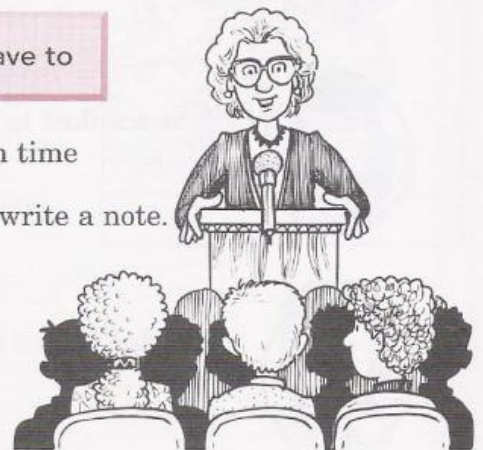
