

PRESENT SIMPLE

We use the Present Simple Tense when talking about things that happen regularly or facts that are always true.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I eat.	I don't eat.	Do I eat?
You eat.	You don't eat.	Do you eat?
We eat.	We don't eat.	Do we eat?
They eat.	They don't eat.	Do they eat?
He eats.	He doesn't eat.	Does he eat?
She eats.	She doesn't eat.	Does she eat?
It eats.	It doesn't eat.	Does it eat?

PRESENT SIMPLE TENSE

THINGS WE DO REGULARLY

We use it to talk about things we do regularly.

Examples: "I play soccer every Saturday."
"They go to school by bus every morning."
"I eat breakfast at 7:00 AM."

DESCRIBING HABITS

We use it to describe things we always do.

Examples: "She always brushes her teeth before bed."
"They usually watch a movie on Friday nights."
"She often visits her grandparents on Sundays."

STATING FACTS AND GENERAL TRUTHS

We use it to state facts that are always true.

Examples: "Water boils at 100 degrees Celsius."
"The sun rises in the east."
"Cats are mammals."
