When we write a lot about one topic, we usually write a paragraph. We don't write numbers in a paragraph. Part A was only for organization. We also leave space at the beginning of the first sentence. This is called "**indent**." We also include a **topic sentence**. A **topic sentence** is like an introduction. It is usually the first sentence of a paragraph. A complete paragraph about my daily routine might look like this:

My Busy Day

I have a busy day. I usually get up at 6:00. At 6:10 I take a shower and get ready. I make coffee at 6:50. Then, I go to work at 7:15. I work from 7:45 to 4:45 every day. I eat lunch at 12:15 Mon to Fri. I go home at 5pm. After I get home, I cook dinner. I usually eat dinner around 7:30pm. I always watch TV at night. I go to bed at 10:30. I am always tired after my busy day.

The last sentence of a paragraph is called a **conclusion**. The **conclusion** is used to indicate the end of the paragraph.
