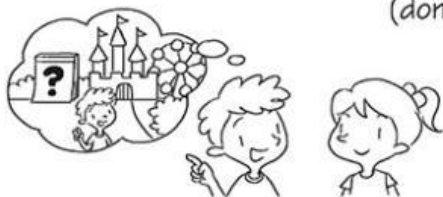

Don't use the **present perfect tense** with:

- ✗ yesterday ✗ last (Monday)
- ✗ in (2005) ✗ (two years) ago

(say when something happened)

I **went** to a theme park last week.Use the **simple past tense** with:

- ✓ yesterday ✓ last (Monday)
- ✓ in (2005) ✓ (two years) ago
