

NEED	SHOULD	MUSTN'T
<ul style="list-style-type: none">dùng need khi ta cần thực hiện một việc gì đó vì nó cần thiếtS + need(s) + to + V-inf.Ex: I need to run in order to keep fit.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">dùng should khi muốn khuyên ai đó nên làm gìS + should + V-inf.Ex: You should go to bed before 10 p.m.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">dùng mustn't khi muốn khuyên ai đó không được làm gìS + mustn't + V-inf.Ex: You mustn't start running without warming up your leg muscles.

2. First conditional sentence with SHOULD (Dạng đảo ngữ của câu điều kiện loại 1)



Ex: If he has a lot of money, he will help poor people.

=> **Should** he **have** a lot of money, he **will help** poor people. (Nếu anh ấy có nhiều tiền, anh ấy sẽ giúp người nghèo.)
