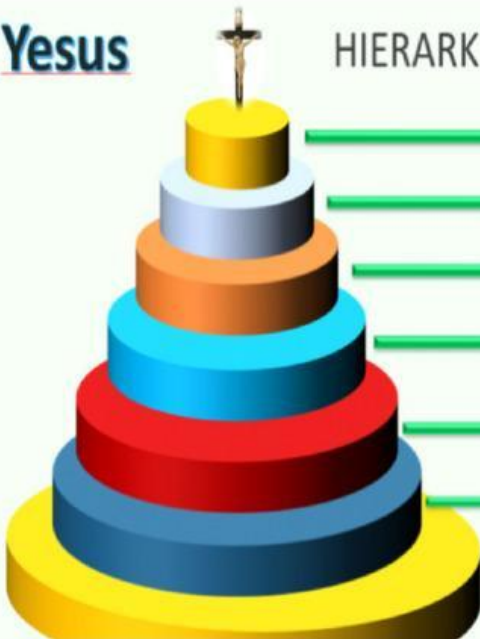

The First Way of Life of the Church

"Those who received his word were baptized; their number increased by about three thousand that day. They persevered in the teaching of the apostles and fellowship. And they always gather to break bread and pray. So, they were all afraid while the apostles performed many miracles and signs. All who have become believers remain united, and all that belongs to them is common. There are always those who sell their possessions and distribute them to every one according to their needs. With perseverance and with one heart, they gather daily in the Temple. They broke the bread in each other's houses in turn and ate together joyfully and with a sincere heart, praising God. And they are liked by everyone. And every day God increases their number with those who are saved." (Act 2:41-47)
