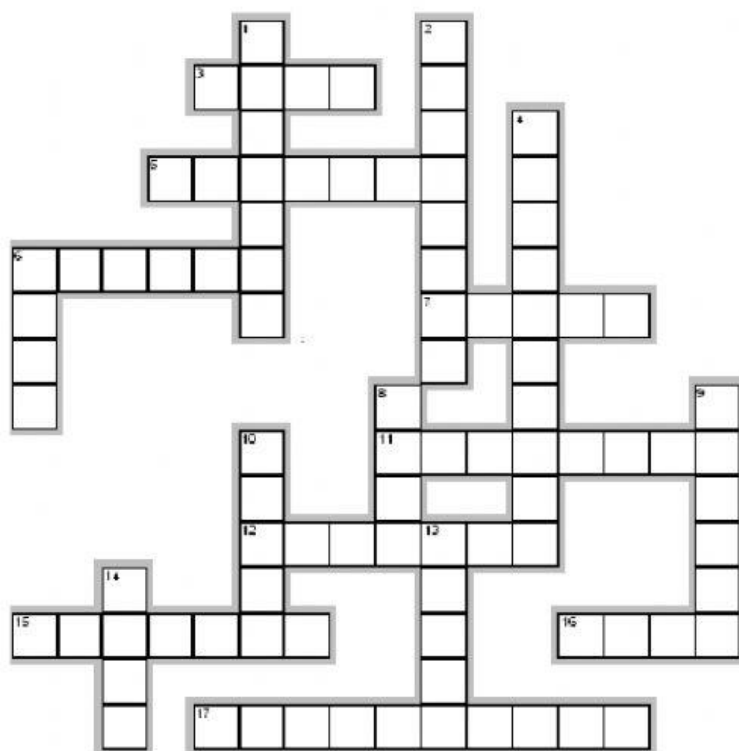


A really fun way to review vocabulary is to mix up the letters of each word. Write a word or words on the board.
