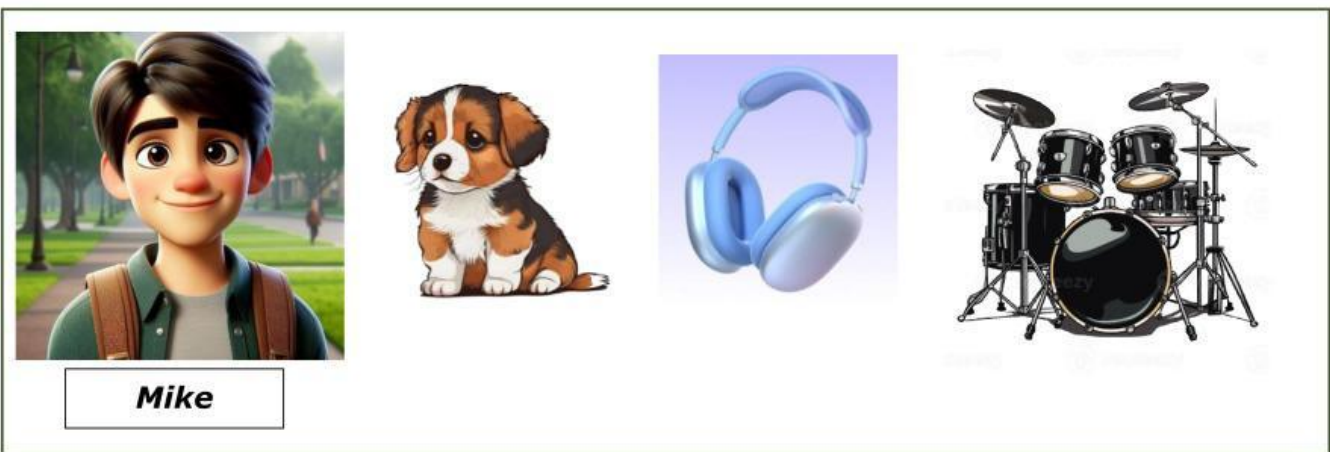
Samantha
