

Subtract Fractions

Aim: to subtract fractions

Subtract the following fractions. You will need to convert the fractions so they all have the same denominator.

1. $\frac{7}{8} - \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

2. $\frac{9}{10} - \frac{3}{4} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

5. $\frac{16}{25} - \frac{3}{5} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
