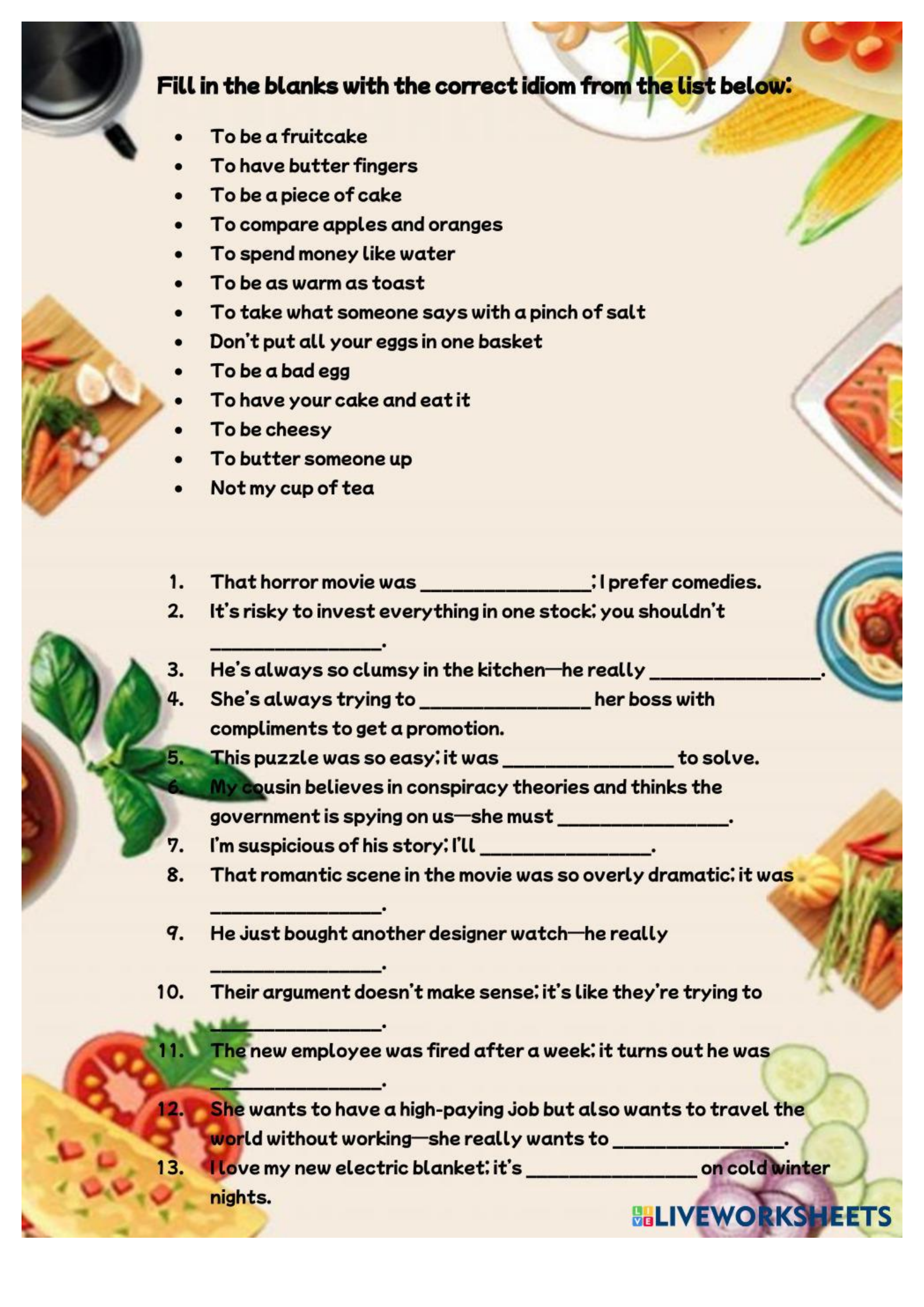




FOOD IDIOMS
