**Transport:**

1. For school bus students — get on the school bus as usual; it will take you to and from the sports ground
2. Other pupils — use public transport
  - a) Bus: 3B, 3D, 3M, 74X, 89, 116, 203E
  - b) MTR: Choi Hung MTR station Exit C2

**Other important points:**

- Students should bring their lunch and drinks for the whole day.
- Parents are welcome to come and watch, but there will be a special seating area for parents. Parents will not sit with the students.
- Students should listen carefully for announcements at the sports ground. If a student misses his / her race, he / she cannot take part in another race.
- Students should take a jacket, a small towel and a cap or hat. Do not take jewellery, toys or mobile phones.
- Parents who will take part in the 4x100 metre relay should arrive at the sports ground no later than 12:00 noon.
- If there is heavy rain, Sports Day will be cancelled. Pupils should go to school as usual.
