


Complete the statement given explaining how Philippine Archipelago was formed.



Many parts of the Philippines originated from oceanic to oceanic \_\_\_\_\_ plate boundary. This resulted from the collision plates, with one of the plates diving under the other.

The Philippine Mobile Belt (also called as Taiwan-Luzon-Mindoro Mobile Belt) is a complex tectonic zone which sits at the convergence zone of the \_\_\_\_\_ Plate, \_\_\_\_\_ Plate and Sunda Plate. The belt is seismically active associated with frequent \_\_\_\_\_ and active volcanism.

The Philippine region has been progressively constructed by plates converging towards each other in multiple directions. The region is bounded by \_\_\_\_\_ zones, where surrounding oceanic plates to the east and west slide towards the center of the Philippine archipelago. Subduction results in deep oceanic \_\_\_\_\_, such as the Philippine Trench and Manila Trench.
