It + The Verb Be

- We use **it** with the verb **be** to talk about the **time, day, date, or weather**.
- It** is used as the subject in sentences.

Time	Day
What time is it ? It is 12 o'clock. It is time for lunch.	What day is it ? It is Saturday. Is it your birthday?
Date	Weather
What is today's date? - It is December 25.	It is hot. It isn't cool. Is it sunny today? It is a nice day.



What time is it?
- It's 7:30.



What day is it?
- It's Wednesday.



What is today's date?
- It's May 25.



How's the weather?
- It's sunny.
