

Present Simple	Present Continuous
Happens <b>every day/year/Monday..., usually, often, always or never</b>  <i>I usually play football...</i>	Is happening <b>right now</b>  <i>... but I am not playing football <b>right now</b>.</i>
For naming a fact  <i>I don't have a dog...</i>	For future arrangements  <i>...but I am getting a puppy soon.</i>
For words that describe a constant state of being: <b>believe, know, like, love, need, understand, want</b>  <i>I like Mike...</i>	For <b>annoying behaviour</b> with always  <i>... but he is <b>always</b> taking my books!</i>

Leia: Hi, Toby. What **are you doing** (you / do)?

Toby: I'm at the sports centre. I **wait** (wait) for Tom.

Leia: What **do** (he/do)?

Toby: I **not know** (not know). He **not answer** (not answer) his phone. Anyway, where are you?

Toby: **you/ like** (you/ like) table tennis? **you/want** (you/want) to play?

Leia: Sure! But I **not wear** (not wear) sports clothes.

Toby: **you/wear** (you/wear) trainers?

Leia: Yes, I am - with jeans and a T-shirt.

Toby: That's fine. You **not need** (not need) sports clothes. See you soon!
