

Present Simple	Present Continuous
Happens <b>every day/year/Monday..., usually, often, always or never</b>  <i>I usually play football...</i>	Is happening <b>right now</b>  <i>... but I am not playing football <b>right now</b>.</i>
For naming a <b>fact</b>  <i>I don't have a dog...</i>	For <b>future arrangements</b>  <i>...but I am getting a puppy soon.</i>
For words that describe a constant state of being: <b>believe, know, like, love, need, understand, want</b>  <i>I like Mike...</i>	For <b>annoying behaviour with always</b>  <i>... but he is <b>always</b> taking my books!</i>
For <b>timetables and schedules</b>  <i>The train leaves at 10:30 a.m.</i>
