

## **Past Unreal Conditional**

**Directions:** Using the words in parentheses, fill in the blanks with the appropriate past unreal conditional form.

**Formulas:**

If + clause in past perfect, + subject + would have + past participle + finisher.

Subject + would have + past participle + finisher + if + clause in past perfect.

**Example:**

- \* If I (own) \_\_\_\_\_ a car, I (drive) \_\_\_\_\_ to work, but I didn't, so I took the bus.
- \* If I had owned a car, I would have driven to work, but I didn't, so I took the bus.
