Greeting & Leave Taking

A. Greeting

Greeting is divided into two, **Formal & Informal**

FORMAL GREETINGS	RESPONSES
• Good morning • Good afternoon • Good evening	• Good morning • Good afternoon • Good evening

Examples

A: Good morning, Mrs. Lina?

B: Good morning, Beni.

INFORMAL GREETINGS	RESPONSES
• Hi • Hello • How are you? • How do you do? • How is life? • Nice to meet you	• Hi • Hello • How are you? • How do you do? • How is life? • Nice to meet you

Examples

A: Hi, Budi?

B: Hi. Amir! How is life?

A: Great, Thank you. How about you?

B: I'm fine

A: Nice to meet you?

B: Nice to meet you too

B. Leave taking (parting)

Leave taking also divided into two, **Formal and Informal**

FORMAL PARTINGS	RESPONSES
• Good night • Good bye • Nice to see you • Nice to meet you. • Good Bye	• Good night • Good bye • Nice to see you, too • Nice to meet you, too. • Good Bye

Examples

A: It's time to go bed, Andi?

B: Yes. Mom

A: Good night, Andi. Have a nice dream

B: Good night mom

INFORMAL PARTINGS	RESPONSES
• Bye • Bye-bye • See you later • See you tomorrow • Take care	• Bye • Bye-bye • See you • See you • Thank you

Examples

A: I'm sorry. I have to go gome?

B: It's okay. Take care. See you tomorrow

A: See you

Note:

1. Good morning used from 00.00 - 11.59
2. Good day/noon used at 12.00
3. Good afternoon used from 12.00-18.00
4. Good Evening used from 18.00-24.00
5. Good night used when we want to sleep
6. AM (Ante Merediem) = from 00.00 until 11.59
7. PM. (Post Merediem) = from 12.00 until 23.59
8. In Indonesia we use 24 hours system, and in England and America they use AM PM sytem

Example Greeting and leave taking:

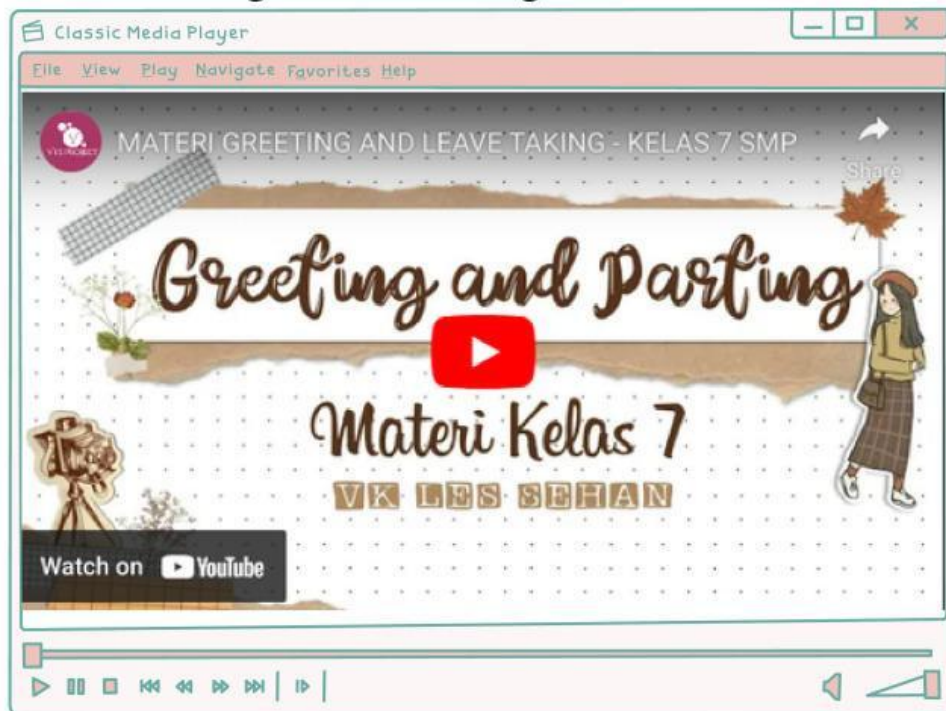
DIALOG 1

• Thank you • Thank you so much • Thank you very much • Thanks a lot • Thanks • Many thanks • Thanks for helping me • Thanks for your help	• You are welcome • Okay • Never mind • All right • Don't mention it • No problem

Examples

A: Can you repair my bike?

B: Okay, I will try

A: Thanks for your help

B: Never mind

D. Apologizing

Apologizing, to apologize is an expressions that is use to say sorry about mistakes that we make to someone else.

APOLOGIZING	RESPONSES
• I'm sorry • Sorry • I'm so sorry • I'm really sorry • Sorry it was my fault • I do apologize • I apologize • Forgive me • Pardon me • Sorry for my mistakes	• That's all right • That's okay • It's all right • It's okay • It's fine • Forget it • Never mind • Don't apologize • It doesn't matter • Don't worry about it.

Examples

A: I'm sorry. I break your toy?

B: It's okay. Never mind. Let's repair it together
