Short forms

He/she/it's	He/she/it isn't
We're	We aren't
You're	You aren't
They're	They aren't

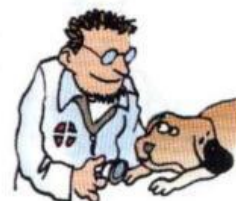
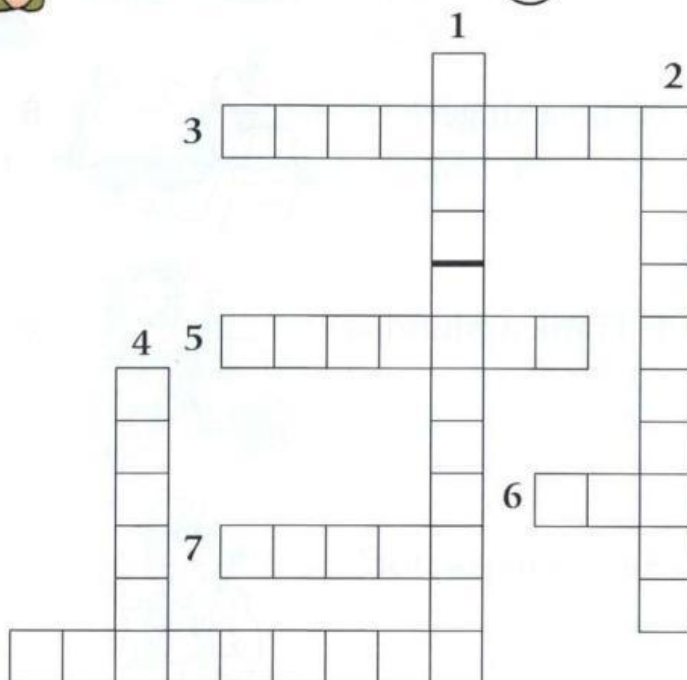
