

Instructions for Students:

1. **Task:** Rearrange the sentence chunks to form a logical and cohesive descriptive text. Pay attention to how each piece describes different elements like the setting, the atmosphere, and the actions.
2. **Hint:** Think about what might happen first, such as the weather changing, and then how the scene builds up in detail (e.g., people reacting to the rain, the cozy indoor space).
3. **Discussion:** After you complete the exercise, discuss how the descriptive details create a mood or feeling in the story and why those details are important.

This activity will help students work on organizing descriptive details while practicing reading comprehension and story structure.

Scrambled Chunks (for students to unscramble): Title: A Rainy Afternoon

- **Discussion:** After completing the activity, discuss as a class how the different elements (sight, sound, smell) contribute to a rich descriptive story.

This type of drill helps students understand the importance of logical flow and cohesive details in descriptive writing.
