

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We use the Present Continuous Tense when talking about things that are happening right now or around the current time.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I am eating. You are eating. We are eating. They are eating. He is eating. She is eating. It is eating.	I am not eating. You aren't eating. We aren't eating. They aren't eating. He isn't eating. She isn't eating. It isn't eating.	Am I eating? Are you eating? Are we eating? Are they eating? Is he eating? Is she eating? Is it eating?

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I am playing.	I am not playing	Am I playing?
He / She / It is playing.	He / She / It isn't playing	Is he / she / it playing?
We / You / They are playing.	We / You / They aren't playing	Are we / you / they playing?
