

HAPPY EASTER

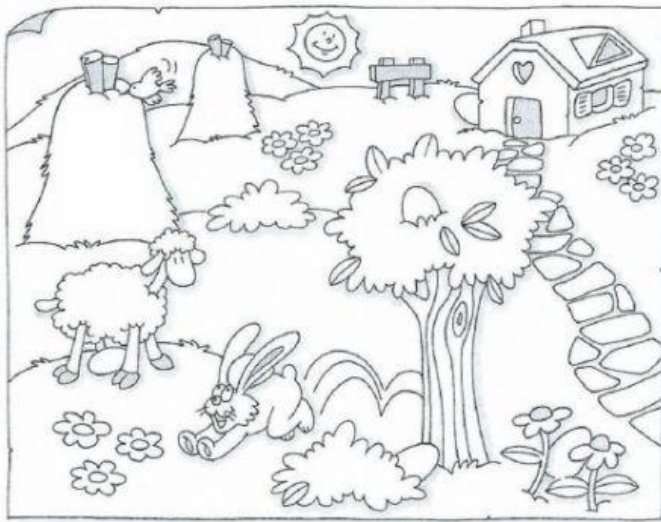
