Hey Lord, I got you

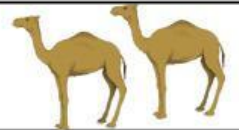

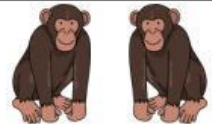
