The table illustrates data about how potato was consumed and produced across various parts of the world 2006.

..... an overall perspective, what stands from the table is that Europe witnessed highest potato consumption per capita **however/ whereas** Asia and Oceania produced a larger quantity opposed to the **other/ others**.

..... detail, with respect the consumption of potato, Europe **headed/ ranked** the list with just over 96 kg per person. Next the list was North America with just under 58kg, although its figure was almost twice high as that of Asia, at roughly 25kg for each. The lowest consumption recorded in Africa at a **mere/ merely** 14.1kg/ person.

As **regarding/ regards** the production, top of the list was Asia and Oceania, just **head/ ahead** of Europe, with a total output of 131.2 and 126.3 million tonnes **respective/ respectively**.

With/ In contrast, the other regions produced the lowest amount of potato, **ranging/ ranged** from approximately 15 around 25 million tonnes.
