Step - A flat surface or a part of a staircase.

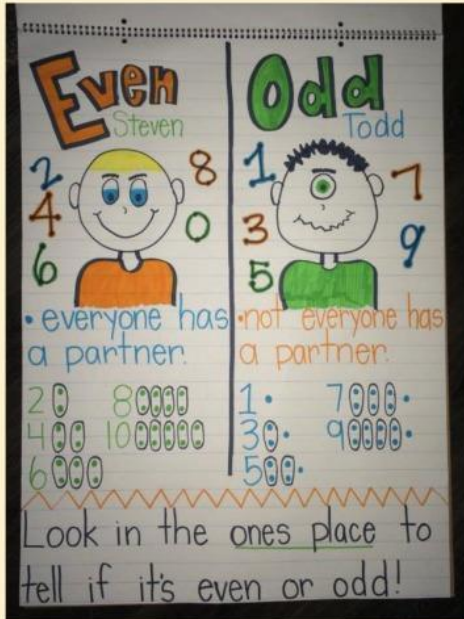
Top - The upper part of an object or the highest part of a mountain.

Place value

PLACE VALUE

The value of a digit is based on its place in a number.

	hundreds	tens	ones
63		6	3

DIGIT
A digit is a symbol that represents a number.
This number has 2 digits.

PLACE
Place is where the digit sits in a number.
The 6 is in the tens place.

VALUE
Value is the amount each digit is worth.
The 6 has a value of 60.

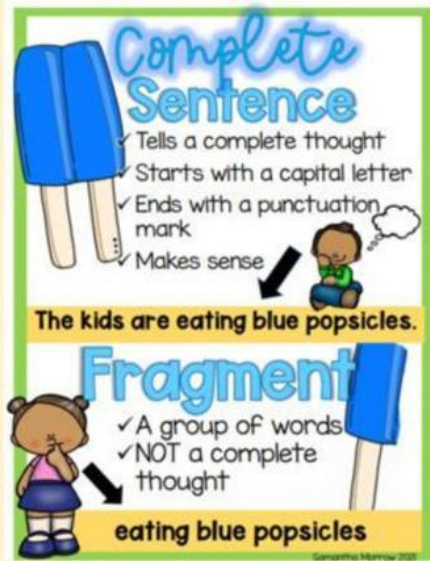
