YOU MUST RECORD A ONE-MINUTE AUDIO ABOUT A SIMILAR STORY PRESENTED IN THIS VIDEO. REMEMBER TO PUT INTO PRACTICE THE GRAMMATICAL STRUCTURE STUDIED: SIMPLE PAST AND PAST CONTINUOUS EXPLAINED IN THE VIDEO.
